## **RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN No. 189 BYLAW NO. 14-2008**

## A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A DISCOUNT FOR EARLY PAYMENT OF TAXES.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts:

- 1. Tax notices of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189 shall be mailed to the respective property owners not later than the first (1st) day of August in each taxation year.
- 2. For payment or prepayment of current tax levies, in whole or in part, the following discounts shall be allowed, subject to section 3 and 4 of this bylaw:

(a)	Payment received on or before the 31st day of August	6%
<b>(b)</b>	Payment received during the month of September	5%
(c)	Payment received during the month of October	4%
(d)	Payment received during the month of November	2%

- The discounts authorized under the provisions of this bylaw shall not apply to 3. local improvement levies.
- In the case of a supplementary Tax Notice, issued after August 10<sup>th</sup>, due to 4. property owner change or assessment change, Council authorizes the Administrator to provide a 6% discount for a one (1) month period from the date of issue. After this one (1) month period the normal discount percentages in effect will apply.
- That Bylaw No. 03-2004, being a Bylaw to Provide a Discount for the Prompt 5. Payment of Current Taxes, adopted on June 9th, 2004 is hereby repealed.
