

BYLAW NO. 03-2007

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No.189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the ATV Bylaw.
2. **PURPOSE:**
The purpose of this bylaw is to prohibit the operation of all terrain vehicles pursuant to Section 11 of *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
3. **Definitions:**
For the purpose of this bylaw, the following terms and words shall have the following meanings:
 - a) **“all-terrain vehicle”** and/or **“ATV”** as described in *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*, means a self propelled vehicle that:
 - i) is designed primarily for the movement of people or goods on unprepared surfaces; and
 - (ii) has wheels in contact with the ground;
and includes:
 - (iii) a restricted use motorcycle;
 - (iv) a mini-bike; and
 - (v) an all terrain cycle;but does not include:
 - (vi) a golf cart;
 - (vii) a snowmobile as defined in *The Snowmobile Act*;
 - (viii) an agricultural implement or special mobile machine as defined in *The Traffic Safety Act* ; or
 - (ix) any vehicle that is required to be registered pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*
 - (b) **“Crown land”** means any land, other than a highway, owned by Her Majesty the Queen in right of Saskatchewan;
 - (c) **“highway”** means highway as defined in *The Traffic Safety Act* ;
4. **INFRACTIONS**
The municipality prohibits the operation of all terrain vehicles on:
 - (a) the untravelled portion of the whole or any part of a highway, other than a provincial highway, in the municipality;
 - (b) any private land in the municipality, without the consent of the landowner, including, any private land in a hamlet or organized hamlet;
 - (c) any municipal land in the municipality; and
 - (d) any Crown land in the municipality that is used or occupied otherwise than by the Crown.
5. **PENALTY:**
 - (a) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.
 - (b) In accordance with Section 32 of *The All Terrain Vehicles Act*, a person who is guilty of an offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than

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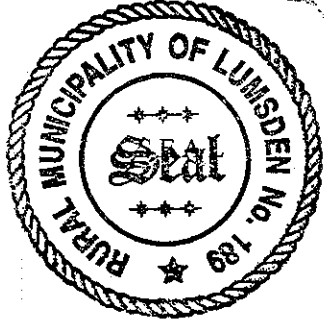
\$1000 and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not more than 30 days.
