

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LUMSDEN NO. 189

BYLAW NO. 04-2016

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 7-2012, known as the Zoning Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No. 189, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 7-2012 as follows:

1. The **Zoning District Map in Section 18.0 – MAPS** is amended by rezoning Parcel C, Plan 70R00362 in the SE-04-20-21-W2 from CR1 – Low Density Country Residential District to CR2 – Medium Density Country Residential District, as shown within the bold line on Schedule "A" attached to this bylaw.
2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Government Relations.

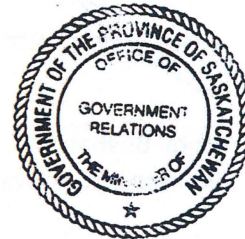

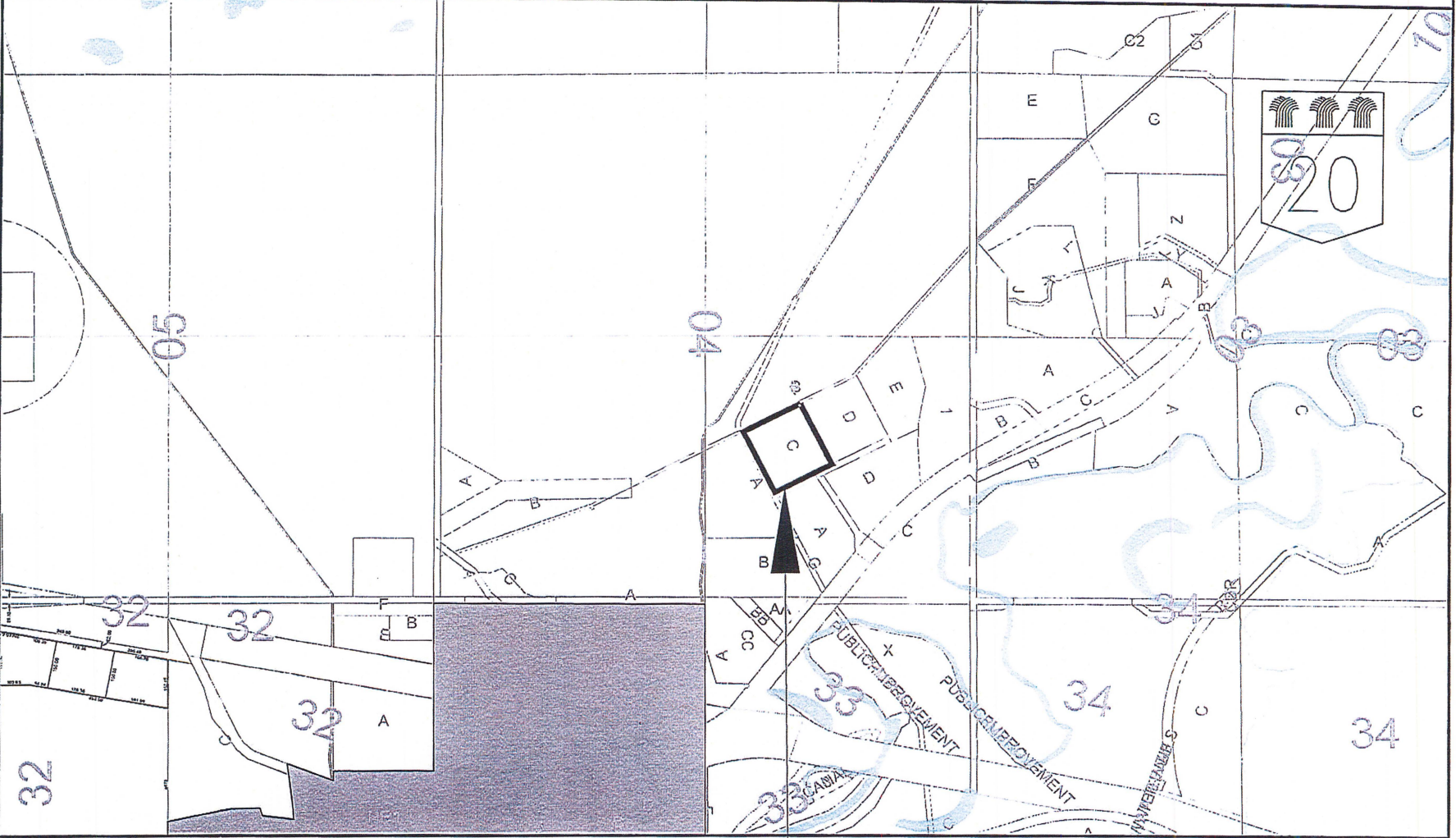
