Across Canada, more than 750 producers have already enrolled over 23,000 acres in the ALUS program.

Farm Stewardship Program (FSP)

Are you seeding tame or native forages?

Ask about our Farm Stewardship Program.

FSP provides Saskatchewan producers funding to implement beneficial management practices (BMPs) in three priority areas – water, climate change and biodiversity.

Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program (FRWIP)

Are you digging a well, dugout, or pipeline? Do you have an old well that needs to be decommissioned?

Ask about our Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program.

FRWIP is designed to support the development of secure and sustainable water sources for agricultural use in Saskatchewan. FRWIP also mitigates the impact of drought, improves public safety, and reduces potential groundwater contamination through well decommissioning.
