BYLAW NO. 17-2014

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 2-99 RESPECTING BUILDINGS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lumsden No.189 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw No. 2-99, being a bylaw respecting buildings, be amended in the following manner:

1. Remove Clause 5(5)(a), Clause 5(5)(b) and Clause 5(5)(c) and replace them with the following: **5. (5)**

- If additional inspection are required (e.g. re-inspection of infractions, progress inspection, any changes to the original permit, stop work order, affidavit review, etc.) an extra fee of \$160.00 will be charged.
- If owner/agent does not call PBI for the next required inspection, the missed inspection(s) will be charged for
- If the "Other" inspection is not needed for a final, framing, progress, re-inspection, etc. it will not be charged.
- Travel is included in the above fees

- If additional inspections are required on minimum fee projects or due to excessive infractions on other building projects, a fee of \$180.00 per inspection will be charged.

(c) Buildings to be moved from within or outside the municipality

- (i) **Pre-move inspection** (applicant billed directly, travel & GST extra) \$480.00
- (ii) **Post-move Inspection** (4 or 5 billing units-see RTM/Modular Home/Post-Move Subclause 5(5)(a)(vi) for details) \$800.00

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2. Add the following Clause 5(5)(d):

5. (5)

(d) Municipal Administration Fee

A 20% municipal administration fee will be applied to all permit amounts stated above.

3. Remove Subsection 5(8) and replace it with the following:

5. (8) Expiry date of building permits

- (a) All building permits expire 2 years after the date of issuance. Building permits may be extended only by applying in writing to the authority having jurisdiction.
- (b) Notwithstanding clause (a), a permit expires and the rights of an owner under the permit terminate, if:
 - (i) the work authorized by the permit is not commenced within six (6) months of the date of issue of the permit and actively carried out thereafter; or
 - (ii) work is suspended for a period of six months, or longer by prior agreement of the council.
- 4. That Bylaw No. 02-2014 is hereby repealed.

5. <u>Effective Date</u>

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the first day of January, 2015.
