



Clubroot Monitoring Program

The 2020 clubroot monitoring program incorporates on-farm testing, external reporting of clubroot by producers and agronomists, and in-field surveillance through the general canola disease survey and a clubroot-specific survey in high-risk areas of the province. The results of the program will be used to update the Saskatchewan Clubroot Distribution Map, which helps increase our understanding of clubroot's distribution in Saskatchewan.

To support on-farm testing, the Ministry of Agriculture and SaskCanola are offering fall clubroot soil testing to Saskatchewan producers. The \$100-value of this test is covered by SaskCanola.
