BYLAW NO. 46/70 A BYLAW TO LICENSE, RECHILATE AND GOVERN PLACES OF AMUSEMENT Bylaw **Amendments** The council of the Rural Municipality of Lamsden No. 189 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows: -No..... 1. Every person conducting a place of amusement within the municipality shall first apply for a license from the No..... secretary treasurer, and shall pay therefor in advance: No..... (a) for each motion picture theatre Repealed (b) for each dance hall or pavillion No.... (c) for each other place of amusement 2. No person shall conduct any place of amusement within the municipality without having first obtained a license and paid the prescribed fee. 3. Every place of amusement shall at all times be properly conducted, kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and shall be subject to inspection at any time by the license inspector or health officer and shall meet the requirements of the Public Health Act and the regulations thereunder before an application for a license is considered. 4. Every application for a license shall require prior approval by a resolution of the council of the said municipality before a license is granted. 5. All licenses granted under this bylaw shall expire on the thirty-first day of December next following the date of issue. 6. The person in whose name the license is issued shall be liable to the penalties imposed for an infraction of this bylaw, whether committed by himself or by an employee. 7. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the

provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
