Capital Project Review

Fish Farm and Shirley Andrew Low Level Crossings

Discussion:

- Shirley Andrew ICIP Project #50200101 \$150,000 approved funding
- Fish Farm ICIP Project #50200100 \$150,000 approved funding
- Water Security Agency will accept Low Level Crossings (LLC)
- Flow will need to be established, hydrometric data should be similar to the Trevarga Culvert project
- The RM submitted the grant applications, therefore MPE's involvement with these projects has been minimal
- Fish Farm LLC has functioning culverts

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- Asphalt at Shirley Andrew LLC has a hump and the culvert has partially collapsed resulting in the LLC holding water and acting like a dam
 Action Items:
- Admin to research the grants details related to the Fish Farm LLC
- Admin to determine if the two LLC's can be bundled to share funding, or if funding can be reduced to the Fish Farm LLC and increased for the Shirley Andrew LLC
- MPE will visit the sites

Grid 734 Cement Bridge

Discussion:

- ICIP Project #50200099 \$500,000 approved funding
- This bridge is approximately 100 years old
- This bridge may be replaced with culverts
- Current funding would be sufficient to replace with culverts but not to replace with a new bridge

Action Items:

- Admin to provide last SARM bridge inspection to MPE
- MPE will assess if the bridge can be replaced with culverts (possibly 3 large diameter)

Grid 734 Crack Sealing RFP (Including Deer Valley)

Discussion:

- MPE is working on the Draft Request for Proposals (RFP)
- CAO Monica Merkosky requested that the RFP be posted as soon as possible
 Action Items:
- MPE agreed to ensure that the Deer Valley portion and Grid 734 portion of the crack sealing are bid separately in the RFP

Wascana Creek Erosion Control

Discussion:

- MPE has drafted the preliminary design
- The opinion of probable cost is not complete but anticipated to exceed \$1M
- Preliminary design needs to be reviewed by Water Security Agency
 Action Item:
- MPE will provide opinion of probable cost
